

Data Protection Act

Edinburgh Natural History Society and its officials may hold some or all of the following data about some or all of its members: name, postal and email addresses, phone and fax numbers, duration of membership, other membership information, and offices held. The data may be held in electronic or paper form. The data may be obtained directly from an individual person or a family member.

The data is used in organising the activities of the Society, including, but not limited to, mailing of journals and other literature, publication of lecture and excursion programmes, circulation of Society administration documentation and appointment of officials.

The data may be distributed in paper or electronic form between Council members. Publication of some personal data in paper form may occur in membership and contact lists, journals, lecture and excursion programmes and other literature. Publication on publicly accessible web sites may include names and photographs, but addresses, contact numbers and personal background details will be published ONLY with the explicit consent of the person.

The data will not be available for commercial purposes.
